Dear Chancellor,

I am writing to express the grave concern of the North-east business community following the publication of our latest Quarterly Economic Survey, produced in partnership with Gilson Gray.

The data shows one in four firms across Aberdeen and Aberdeenshire have cut jobs in the last quarter, up from just 12% two years ago. Note that this is across the whole economy, not just the energy sector.

This morning, the Port of Aberdeen has also reported that oil and gas activity is down 10% so far in 2025, and a hugely concerning 25% during the key summer months when offshore projects and maintenance traditionally peak.

There has been no uplift in renewable energy work of a scale to replace this, which means fewer vessels, fewer supplies and less equipment heading offshore. This translates directly into less work for the region's world-class supply chain.

The Energy Profits Levy is accelerating this decline, driving away investment, undermining confidence and now threatening jobs across the whole economy, not just the energy sector. The North-east remains the engine room of the UK's energy economy. But that engine is running on empty.

We urge you to use the forthcoming Budget to abolish the Energy Profits Levy and replace it with a stable, long-term fiscal framework that encourages investment, sustains employment and restores confidence.

Without decisive action, we risk plunging over the very cliff edge that ministers have repeatedly said we must avoid.

I have attached a full copy of the Quarterly Economic Survey, alongside our recent pre-Budget submission, for your consideration as you prepare for what is a make-or-break Autumn Budget for our region.
